NEW KENTUCKY IMMUNIZATION FORM UPDATES

Please read the letter regarding updated immunization requirements (specifically for the Hepatitis A vaccine) for the 2018-2019 school year. A recent amendment on the immunization schedules added new immunization requirements for the school year beginning on or after July 1, 2018. Effective July 1, 2018, **ALL** students in Kindergarten through twelfth grade must show proof of having received two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine to attend school. To meet this requirement, a **CURRENT** certificate of Immunization Status must be provided to the school showing the dates your child received the two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine. **These shots must be done by the FIRST day of school in August.** If you have any further questions, please contact your child's physician or nurse.
