NEW KENTUCKY IMMUNIZATION FORM UPDATES

A recent amendment on the immunization schedules added new immunization requirements for the school year beginning on or after July 1, 2018. Effective July 1, 2018, **ALL** students in Kindergarten through twelfth grade must show proof of receiving two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine to attend school. To meet this requirement, a **CURRENT** certificate of Immunization Status must be provided to the school showing the dates your child received the two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine. **These shots must be done before the FIRST day of school in August.** If you have any further questions, please contact your child's physician or nurse.

2018-2019 TUITION & SCHOLARSHIP PAPERWORK

In order to be eligible for the Tuition Assistance Form, you must also turn in a copy of your front page of last year's Form 1040, which notes the AGI. If you are applying for the Sister Mary deLellis Scholarship and/or the Tuition Assistance Form, **please turn in your paperwork to the office by THIS Friday, May 11th deadline.**
