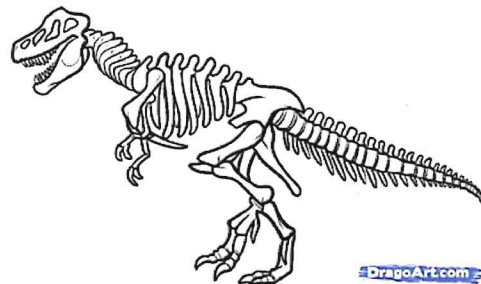

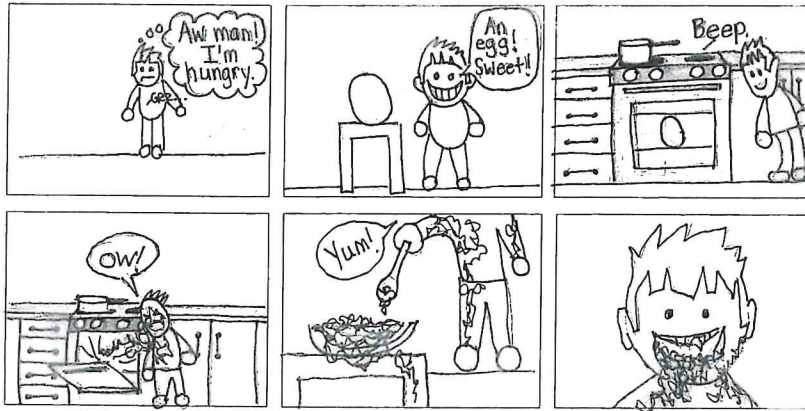

so who will start the bidding?

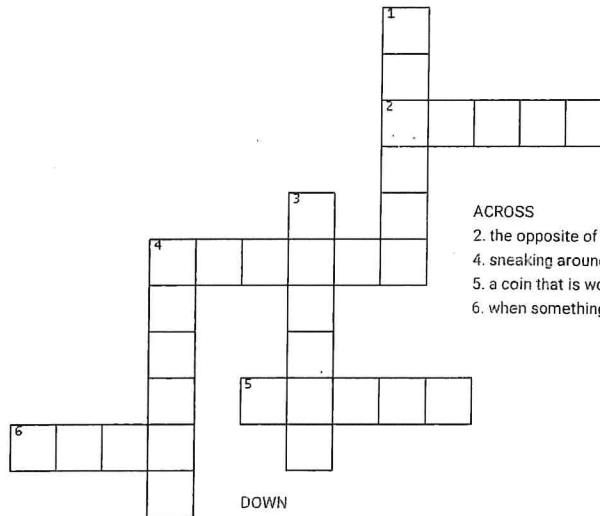
